
What makes you smile on a summer night? Fireworks displays! Follow each path to find out what these teeth will see in the 4th of July sky.




Tic-Tac-Tooth

Decode the secret smile message below to find out how!


Add up the numbers represented by each set of symbols and replace them with the corresponding letter.




Unscramble the words by following the floss path and then write the letter in the box.




I. These flat front teeth are for biting into food.



2. These teeth tear food into smaller pieces.







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Pin the Mouth on the Monster


They player who is closest to having the mouth in the right position wins!

Hermey the Elf always brushes his teeth two times a day, for two minutes, and you should too!



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


















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




































Snowflake Template 1

You can color the booklet cover before you fold and cut, or afterward.


Turn your printout so this side faces up.
